Enrich your child's summer experience in the Montessori classroom with a fun and educational camp!

Campers ages 2.5 & up participate in creative and engaging guided activities, experiments, and projects based on the theme of each camp. They will enjoy free explorations and lessons in all areas of the classroom—Practical Life, Sensorial, Language, Math and Cultural. Camps are led and designed by experienced Montessori teachers. Ample time outdoors features an outdoor easel, gardening activities (including planting, watering, weeding, and harvesting), group games, and, of course PLAY!

The Half-day program is 8:30-12:00. Full-day campers stay for lunch followed by an afternoon session for more explorations, crafts, projects and free choice. Dismissal for the Full-Day program is 3:00-3:15. Students under the age of 4 may attend the Full-day camp with staff approval; those 5 and under will have a short afternoon rest. Students will bring packed lunches; families send water and snacks at the beginning of the week.
